

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
NEBRASKA FINANCIAL EDUCATION COALITION
An Affiliate of the National Jump\$tart Coalition

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of 21 years or more, acting as organizer of a Nebraska not-for-profit corporation, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I
Name

The name of the Corporation is: Nebraska Financial Education Coalition (the Corporation).

ARTICLE II
Nature of Corporation

The Corporation is a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE III
Registered Office and Registered Agent

The street address of the Corporation's initial registered office is: Federal Reserve Bank, 2201 Farnam Street, Omaha, NE 68102. The name of the Corporation's initial registered agent at such address is Jennifer Clark.

ARTICLE IV
Incorporator

The name and street address of the Incorporator are: Jennifer Clark, 2201 Farnam Street, Omaha, NE 68102.

ARTICLE V
Members

The Corporation shall have members. The Bylaws of the Corporation shall set forth the criteria or procedures for admission of such members and the qualifications, rights and obligations of such members.

ARTICLE VI
Dissolution

The Corporation may be dissolved as provided by law. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively for charitable or educational purposes or to organizations which are then exempt from federal tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and to which contributions are then deductible under Section 170(c)(2)

of such code.

ARTICLE VII

Purposes

The Corporation is organized and shall be administered and operated to receive, administer, and expend funds exclusively for the following educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code:

- (a) To strengthen personal financial literacy for all Nebraskans;
- (b) To assist other charitable and educational organizations in the conduct of similar activities; and
- (c) To engage in any and all lawful activities incidental to the foregoing purposes except as restricted herein.

In order to accomplish the foregoing charitable and educational purposes, and for no other purpose or purposes, this corporation shall have all the powers given under the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE VIII

Restriction on Activities

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article VII above. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
